ELIGIBILITY

1. The applicant must be an active (dues current) member of Phi Kappa Phi or have accepted membership by June 30;
2. The applicant must be currently enrolled in an undergraduate program;
3. The applicant cannot be a sitting Phi Kappa Phi board member, divisional vice president, member of the Pioneer Award Program committee or Society employee.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Selection is based on the applicant's promise of continued success in baccalaureate study, as evidenced by:

1. Academic achievement, honors and awards, and relevant research experience;
2. Service and leadership experience, on and off campus
3. Personal Statement
4. Letter of recommendation
