2. To pursue the proposed study abroad plan as described in my application, unless prior approval of changes in my plans is secured from Society Headquarters.
3. To submit, on time, any reports required by Phi Kappa Phi and to notify Society Headquarters of any circumstances that may alter my student status.
4. To submit a summary report of my accomplishments (approximately 350 words) to Society Headquarters within 45 days of my return from the experience abroad.
