

THE HONOR SOCIETY OF PHI KAPPA PHI ARTIST AWARD

The Phi Kappa Phi Artist Award honors those individuals who demonstrate the ideals of the Society through their activities, achievements, and scholarship. Awardees receive \$1,000 honoraria, a one year active membership and a recognition certificate. The Artist Award was established in 1983 to recognize the achievements of those who, in addition to their outstanding scholarship, have displayed talents in the broad realm of the arts—creative, graphic, performing, visual, and/or fine arts. This award is given once per biennium.

ELIGIBILITY & DEADLINE

1. Chapters and active members are encouraged to nominate one individual for this award; self-nominations are encouraged.
2. Although nominees are often faculty members at colleges and universities, a chapter or any active member may nominate an active Society member who is not institution-affiliated provided all criteria are met.
3. The nominee must be an active member with current dues paid as of February 15, 2012.
4. All materials must be submitted on or before February 15, 2012.

SELECTION CRITERIA

1. Distinguished record of past accomplishments in the arts (visual arts, performing arts, applied arts, and humanities).
2. Documented evidence of national or international prominence and visibility.
3. Demonstrated ability to promote excellence in the arts.
4. Acknowledged by peers in the field through national and international awards or other means of recognition.

PROCESS & EXPECTATIONS

After the Board approves the recipient, nominees, presidents of nominating chapters, or individual nominators will be informed of the results. The Award recipient will be presented with a check for \$1,000, a one year active membership in Phi Kappa Phi, a recognition certificate and an invitation to the Convention in August 2012. Travel, lodging and meal expenses incurred by the recipient in attending the Convention will be fully reimbursed according to the Society travel policy.
