

CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

This is the official call for nominations for Phi Kappa Phi Society Officers and Regional Representatives. Please note that significant changes in the elected positions were approved by the 2007 and 2010 Conventions.

President William Bloodworth has appointed the following individuals to serve as members of the Phi Kappa Phi Nominating Committee for 2010-2012: Dr. Cassandre Alvarado (SC), Dr. Kathy Brown (SE), Dr. Joanne Brown-Cameron (W), Dr. Bradley Skelcher (NE), and Dr. Robert Rogow (Immediate Past Society President). Lourdes Barro, Acting Executive Director, is the Committee's staff representative.

Specifically, the Nominating Committee is charged with developing a slate of not fewer than two candidates for the offices of **Society President-Elect, Vice President for Marketing and Member Benefits, Vice President for Fellowships and Awards, Vice President for Finance, and each of the five Regional Representatives for Chapter Relations** to present to the delegates at the 2012 Convention to be held in St. Louis on August 10-11, 2012. In addition, the election of **two (2) Vice Presidents at Large** will be held electronically by the Society's active members in April. Please consider nominating eligible and consenting candidates for these important offices. Position descriptions for each of the elected offices have been enclosed. **The deadline for submitting all nomination packets is February 24, 2012.** The Nominating Committee's slate of candidates will be announced in April 2012. Additional nominations of eligible and consenting candidates for all but the two (2) Vice Presidents at Large may be made from the Convention floor.

All elected Society officers and Regional Representatives will assume the duties of their respective offices at the close of the 2012 Convention in St. Louis. Additional information regarding job responsibilities may be found in Article IV, Sections 2, 3, and 4 of the Society Bylaws. 1. Letter of Nomination (1 page) from Chapter President or individual nominator (include e-mail address of nominator)
2. Letter of Consent (1 page) from Nominee (willingness to serve if elected)
3. Résumé of Nominee (2 pages) on 8 ½ x 11" paper
4. Personal Statement (1 page) from Nominee (should address the Nominee's goals, plans, and objectives for the future of The Honor Society of Phi Kappa Phi)
