

# **AWARD OPPORTUNITIES**

The Honor Society of Phi Kappa Phi's ongoing commitment to excellence is reflected in its award programs. More than \$1.3 million is awarded each year to outstanding members through the Society's various programs.

# PIONEER AWARDS 50 AWARDED ANNUALLY | DEADLINE: JUNE 1

Phi Kappa Phi Pioneer Awards are designed to encourage and reward undergraduate members for developing the research, engagement and leadership skills necessary to become a successful scholar. Each year, 50 \$1,000 awards are distributed.

# FELLOWSHIPS 62 AWARDED ANNUALLY | LOCAL DEADLINES VARY | NATIONAL DEADLINE: APRIL 15

Each year, Phi Kappa Phi awards 54 Fellowships of \$8,500 each, six of \$20,000 each and two of \$35,000 to members entering their first year of graduate or professional study. Each chapter may select one candidate from its local applicants to compete Society-wide.

#### **STUDY ABROAD GRANTS** 125 AWARDED ANNUALLY | DEADLINE: MARCH 15

Study Abroad Grants are designed to help support undergraduates as they seek knowledge and experience in their academic fields by studying abroad. Seventy-five grants of \$1,000 each are awarded every year.

#### **DISSERTATION FELLOWSHIPS** 15 AWARDED ANNUALLY | DEADLINE: NOVEMBER 30

The Dissertation Fellowship Program supports doctoral candidates who are in the dissertation writing stage of doctoral study. Each year, Phi Kappa Phi awards 10 Dissertation Fellowships of \$10,000 each.

#### **GRADUATE RESEARCH GRANTS** 20 AWARDED ANNUALLY | DEADLINE: NOVEMBER 30

Grants of up to \$1,500 are available to members attending graduate school to provide funding for research experiences in support of career development.

#### **LOVE OF LEARNING AWARDS** 200 AWARDED ANNUALLY | DEADLINE: JUNE 30

Love of Learning Awards help fund post-baccalaureate professional development for active Phi Kappa Phi members including graduate or professional studies, doctoral dissertations, continuing education, career development, travel related to teaching and research, and more. Two hundred awards, of \$1,000 each, are distributed each year.

#### LITERACY GRANTS VARIABLE NUMBER AWARDED ANNUALLY | DEADLINE: APRIL 1

The Literacy Grants program was created to mobilize members and resources of Phi Kappa Phi and the higher education community to champion literacy initiatives. Grants of up to \$2,500 are available to Phi Kappa Phi chapters and individual members to fund ongoing literacy projects or to create new initiatives.

# MARY TODD SABBATICAL AWARD VARIABLE NUMBER AWARDED ANNUALLY | DEADLINE: OCTOBER 1

In honor of former Executive Director Dr. Mary Todd, the Society will honor one faculty member with a \$50,000 award to support a sabbatical year or similar reassignment of duties.

# **SCHOLAR & ARTIST AWARDS** ONE EACH AWARDED EVERY BIENNIUM | DEADLINE: FEBRUARY 1 (of even years)

The Phi Kappa Phi Scholar Award and Phi Kappa Phi Artist Award honors individuals who demonstrate the ideals of the Society through their career achievements and scholarship.

# **RAY SYLVESTER DISTINGUISHED SERVICE AWARD** ONE AWARDED EVERY BIENNIUM | DEADLINE: FEBRUARY 1 (of even years)

The Ray Sylvester Distinguished Service Award honors an individual who has provided sustained, non-compensated volunteer service to others beyond the realm of academia.
