RITA DOVE won the 1987 Pulitzer Prize in Poetry for her collection *Thomas and Beulah*. In 1993, at age 40, Dove became the youngest person and first African American to be appointed Poet Laureate of the United States. She currently serves as Commonwealth Professor of English at the University of Virginia. Dove was initiated into Phi Kappa Phi at Miami University in 1973.
