PIONEER AWARDS

50 AT \$1,500 FOR UNDERGRADUATE RESEARCH

Phi Kappa Phi Pioneer Awards are designed to encourage and reward undergraduate members for developing the research, engagement and leadership skills necessary to become a successful scholar. Fifty \$1,500 awards are distributed annually.

DEADLINE

All materials must be submitted through the online portal on or before **JUNE 1**.

ELIGIBILITY

The competition is open to Phi Kappa Phi members in all fields of study who meet each of the following requirements:

1. Be an active (dues current) member of Phi Kappa Phi or have accepted membership by June 30, 2027.
2. Be currently enrolled in an undergraduate program.
3. Not be a sitting Phi Kappa Phi board member, divisional vice president, member of the Pioneer Award Program committee or Society employee at the time of application or announcement.
4. Have not received a previous Pioneer Award.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Selection is based on the applicant's promise of continued success in baccalaureate study, as evidenced by:

1. Academic achievement, honors and awards, and relevant research experience
2. Service and leadership experience, on and off campus
3. Personal statement
4. Letter of recommendation
