Phi Kappa Phi awards more than \$1 million each year to qualifying students and members through study abroad grants, graduate fellowships, funding for post-baccalaureate development, member and chapter awards, and grants for local, national and international literacy initiatives.

FELLOWSHIPS

40 at \$8,500
6 at \$15,000

Since 1932, Phi Kappa Phi has awarded fellowships to members entering their first year of graduate or professional study. Each chapter may submit one candidate to the national competition by April 15.

GRADUATE RESEARCH GRANTS

50 at \$1,500

Awarded to active members attending graduate school. These grants provide funding for research in support of career development opportunities.

Deadline to apply: November 30

LITERACY GRANTS

Up to \$2,500

The Literacy Grant Program was created in 2003 to provide funding to Phi Kappa Phi chapters and individual members for ongoing literacy projects or new initiatives.

Deadline to apply: April 1

PIONEER AWARDS

50 at \$1,500

Designed to encourage and reward undergraduate members for developing the research, engagement and leadership skills necessary to become a successful scholar.

Deadline to apply: June 1

STUDY ABROAD GRANTS

50 at \$1,000

Phi Kappa Phi's Study Abroad Grants help support undergraduates as they seek knowledge and experience in their academic fields by studying abroad.

Deadline to apply: March 15

DISSERTATION FELLOWSHIP

12 at \$10,000

The Phi Kappa Phi Dissertation Fellowship program was introduced in 2014 to support members in the dissertation writing phase of doctoral study.

Deadline to apply: November 30

LOVE OF LEARNING AWARDS

200 at \$1,000

Love of Learning Awards help fund post baccalaureate research and career development for active Phi Kappa Phi members including graduate or professional research, doctoral dissertations, continuing education, career development, travel related to teaching and research, and more.

Deadline to apply: June 30

MARY TODD SABBATICAL

\$50,000 award

Honoring one faculty member with a \$50,000 award to support a sabbatical year or similar reassignment of duties.

Deadline to apply: October 1

SCHOLAR, ARTIST, SERVICE

\$1,000 awards

Recognizing lifetime achievement in scholarly and artistic endeavors and volunteer service.

Deadline to apply: April 1
