STUDY ABROAD GRANTS

50 \$1,000 GRANTS FOR STUDYING ABROAD

Phi Kappa Phi Study Abroad Grants are designed to help support undergraduates as they seek knowledge and experience in their academic fields by studying abroad.

50 \$1,000 grants are awarded each year.

Applicants do not have to be Society members but must attend an institution with an active Phi Kappa Phi chapter.

ELIGIBILITY

Open to any undergraduate student (you do not have to be a member) who meets the following requirements:

1. Attend an institution with an active Phi Kappa Phi chapter;
2. Have a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of at least 3.75 on a 4.0 scale (3.74 does not qualify);
3. The study abroad program must begin between May 1, 2027 and June 30, 2028;
4. Must have applied and/or been accepted into a study abroad program (provide the letter of acceptance on official letterhead as part of your application*);
5. Previous winners are not eligible to apply.

**If an official letter of acceptance is not available at the time of submission, then the applicant may obtain a letter from his or her school (on official letterhead) verifying the submission of an application and the student's intent to travel abroad.*

DEADLINE

All materials must be submitted through the online portal on or before **MARCH 15**.
